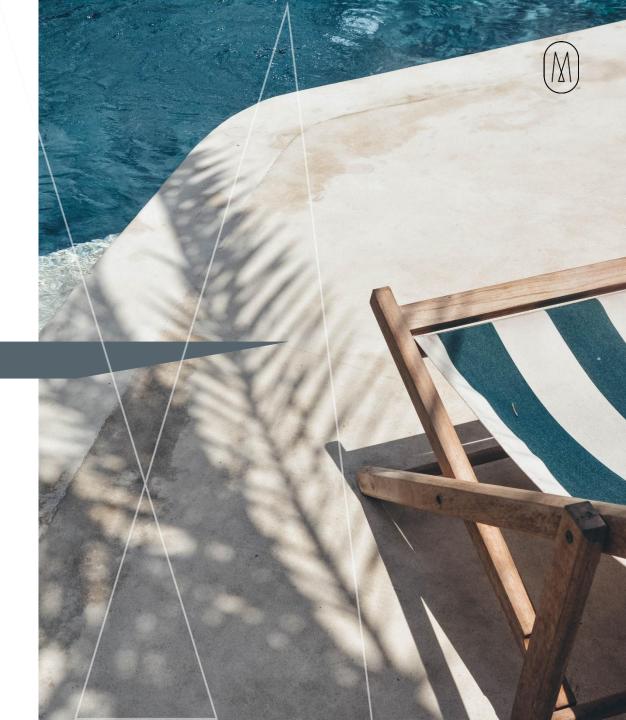

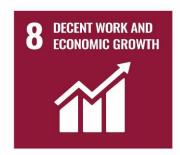

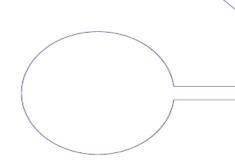
***** WATER MANAGEMENT



At MGallery The Bodrum Hotel Yalıkavak, we value water, our most important natural resource, and implement necessary conservation and control measures. The hotel largely converts seawater into usable water through an osmosis system.

We conduct daily, monthly, and yearly water consumption analyses using GAIA 2.0 (AccorHotels Sustainability & Technical Platform). These analyses allow us to monitor water usage both in total and per guest.

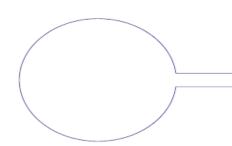
All faucets and urinals in our hotel are sensor-operated and designed for low water consumption.
Water-saving systems are implemented in guest areas, staff areas, and guest rooms to reduce overall water usage.

Washbasin faucets:
Maximum flow rate 4 liters/minute
Wall-mounted shower

Wall-mounted shower heads: Maximum flow rate 9 liters/minute Kitchen, restaurant, and

bar faucets: Flow rate 6–8 liters/minute

Landscape irrigation: Drip irrigation is used as the primary method These measures ensure efficient water use and contribute to sustainable resource management.

No bottled water is purchased, and all guest rooms are equipped with environmentally friendly toiletries.









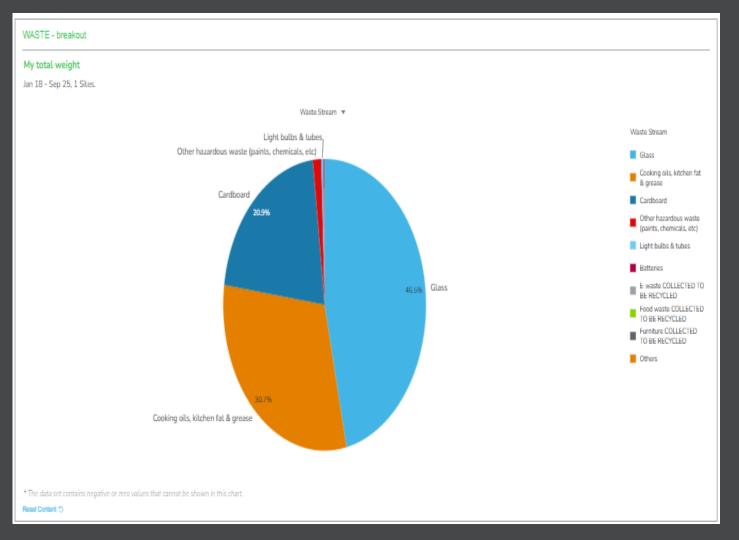








❖ WASTE MANAGEMENT



All waste generated at our hotel is separated in accordance with relevant regulations and sent to licensed companies for recycling or disposal: **Vegetable Waste Oils**: Waste oils from our kitchen are regularly collected and delivered to licensed companies.

Packaging Waste (plastic, glass, metal, paper): Collected separately at the source and sent for recycling.

Organic Waste: Organic waste from the kitchen and food & beverage areas is regularly disposed of.

Hazardous Waste: Batteries, fluorescent lamps, cleaning chemicals, and medical waste are collected in special containers and delivered to authorized companies.

Electronic Waste: End-of-life devices and equipment are handed over to licensed recycling companies.

These processes are regularly monitored, and both our staff and guests are educated on proper waste separation practices.

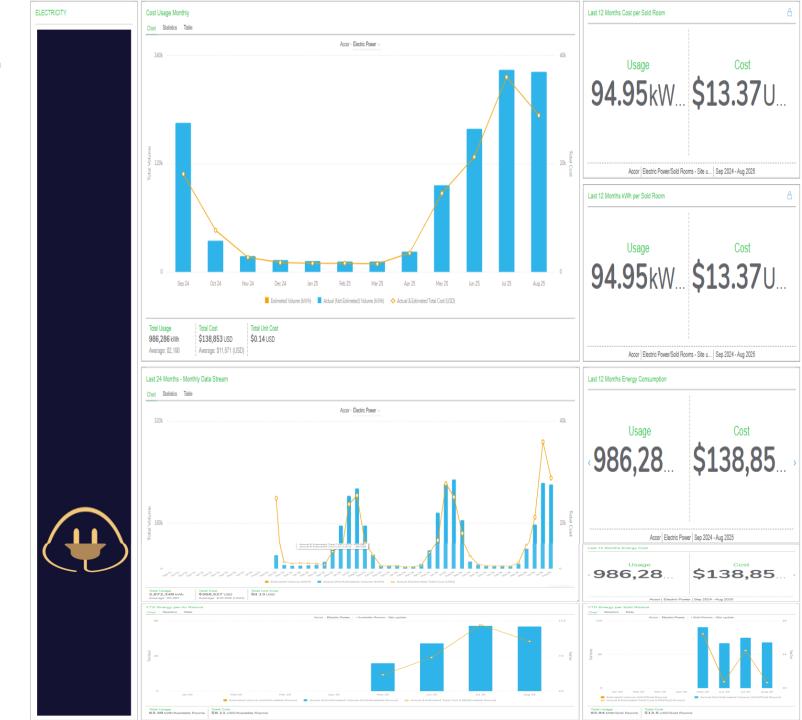
5.ENERGY MANAGEMENT

To increase energy efficiency, our hotel uses top-level energy-saving systems. Energy consumption is regularly monitored daily, monthly, and yearly through the GAIA 2.0 system. In guest rooms, automatic energy shut-off systems and window/door sensors prevent unnecessary usage. Lighting in common areas is controlled by sensors and timers, and low-consumption LED lighting is used throughout the property. Additionally, all rooms are equipped with A-class energy-efficient televisions and minibar refrigerators.













Energy Management and Renewable Resources

We aim to reduce our energy consumption and the associated carbon emissions every year. Our energy efficiency efforts are continuously analyzed through regular maintenance, supervision, and monitoring. We plan our new investments with a focus on renewable energy sources.

In this context, solar panels have been installed in our parking areas, an electric vehicle charging station has been established, and the use of renewable energy has been increased through Solar Energy System (SES) projects. Our annual utilization rate of the Solar Energy System is **26.74%**.

To reduce carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions and mitigate climate change, we utilize renewable energy sources and support afforestation efforts by donating saplings to prevent deforestation.

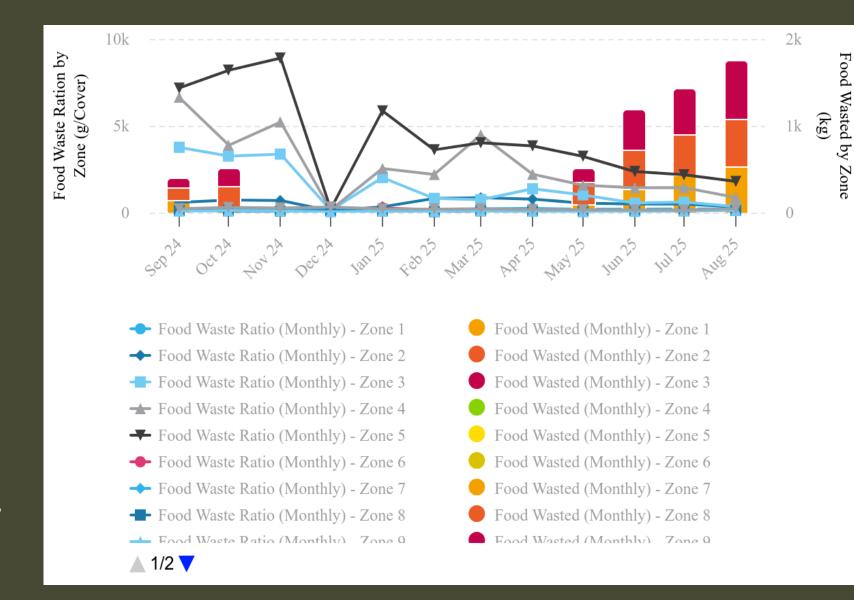




❖ FOOD MANAGEMENT



At MGallery The Bodrum Hotel Yalıkavak, we implement the necessary saving and control measures to minimize food waste. Our hotel manually measures food waste and records monthly and annual food waste ratios through GAIA (AccorHotels Sustainability & Technical Platform).



6.BIODIVERSITY

Biodiversity refers to the variety of plants, animals, fungi, and the ecological processes they are part of. The Bodrum region possesses rich biodiversity and is notable for its endemic and local species.

Some of the prominent species in the region include:

Plants: Bodrum tangerine, prickly pear, olive, lavender, thistle, glasswort, carob, nettle, snake's tongue, wild asparagus, gum rockrose.

Animals: Sole fish, red mullet, Mediterranean monk seal.





















7. SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR) INITIATIVES

At **MGallery The Bodrum Hotel Yalıkavak**, we supported various non-governmental organizations and local initiatives throughout 2025, guided by our commitment to social responsibility.

Gender Equality: We hosted the Gender Equality Office of Bodrum Municipality's Women and Family Services Directorate and organized a training session in our meeting rooms.

Environment and Climate: In line with our goal to minimize carbon emissions, we donated 20 saplings to the **TEMA Foundation**.

Cultural Contribution: We supported **PEKSEM Theatre**, featuring performances by individuals with disabilities, by purchasing tickets.

Education Support: We provided financial and material support, including chemicals, to **Bodrum Gölköy Ahmet Naci Primary School**.

Local Community Collaboration: Together with the local community **MİSGİBİ1BODRUM**, we carried out an environmental cleanup at **Küdür Bay**.





















































8. CHEMICAL MANAGEMENT



- * We work with authorized companies for the safe disposal of chemical waste and monitor all processes.
- We ensure that the chemicals we use are approved, labeled, packaged appropriately, and accompanied by MSDS documents.
- Necessary precautions against leaks and spills are taken in our storage areas; storage is carried out according to manufacturer instructions and relevant regulations.
- To reduce environmental impact, we use dosing systems and prefer equipment that consumes less chemicals and water.
- ❖ Whenever possible, we use eco-friendly and Ecolabel-certified products.













9. PURCHASING ACTIVITIES

We aim to reduce delivery-related CO₂ emissions by sourcing our procurement processes as much as possible from **local suppliers**. In this way, we minimize the environmental impacts caused by vehicle use and energy consumption.

Accordingly, we regularly update our sustainability criteria and share them transparently with our stakeholders.

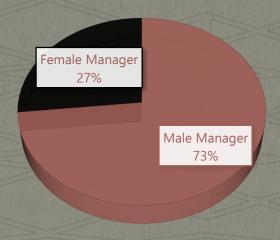




TOTAL EMPLOYEES LOCAL/NON-LOCAL

11. CHILD ABUSE AND HARASSMENT PREVENTION

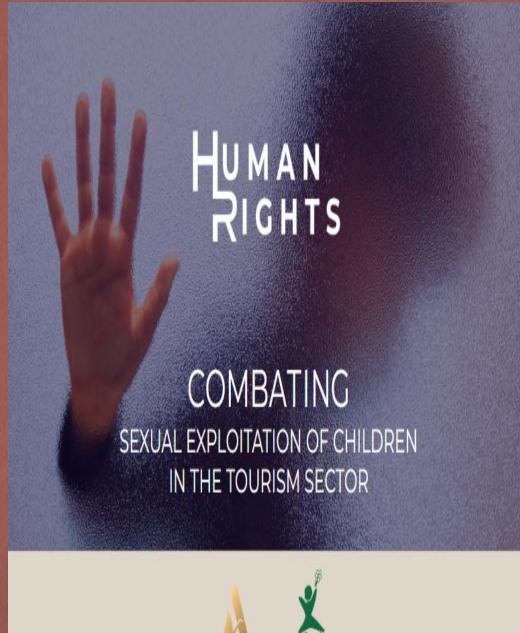
We believe that protecting children is everyone's responsibility. Ensuring child welfare and safeguarding children from any form of harm are among our top priorities. Protecting all children we are involved with from physical and psychological abuse is one of the most important duties of our hotel.

Our Practices

Training: All our team members receive regular training on the types of child abuse (physical, sexual, emotional abuse, and neglect), reporting processes, and our social responsibilities. Child Labor: We do not employ underage staff (except those engaged for internships or vocational training purposes). International Standards: Through Accor's INES system, all our employees have been trained under the WATCH program – We Act Together for Children – to combat the sexual exploitation of children in the tourism sector.

13. PROMOTION OF CULTURAL HERITAGE

We introduce Bodrum's historical and cultural sites to our guests through visuals accessible via a QR code system, ensuring easy and convenient access.



















We aim to introduce our guests to the region's culinary culture, geographically indicated products, activities, and traditions. In addition, we provide information to encourage visits to significant local sites, including religious, cultural, and natural landmarks. As part of this initiative, we also conduct regular training for our employees.

To support local promotion, our beach menu features regional specialties such as Bodrum Artichoke, Bodrum Mandarin Callamansi, Bodrum Sea Bass, and Bodrum Salad. We enhance the guest experience by offering Bodrum Mandarin Soda in guest rooms and include Bodrum Satsuma Mix in our cocktails to showcase local flavors.

Furthermore, we regularly share information about the surrounding cultural heritage through our info channels, ensuring that our guests can easily access and engage with it.

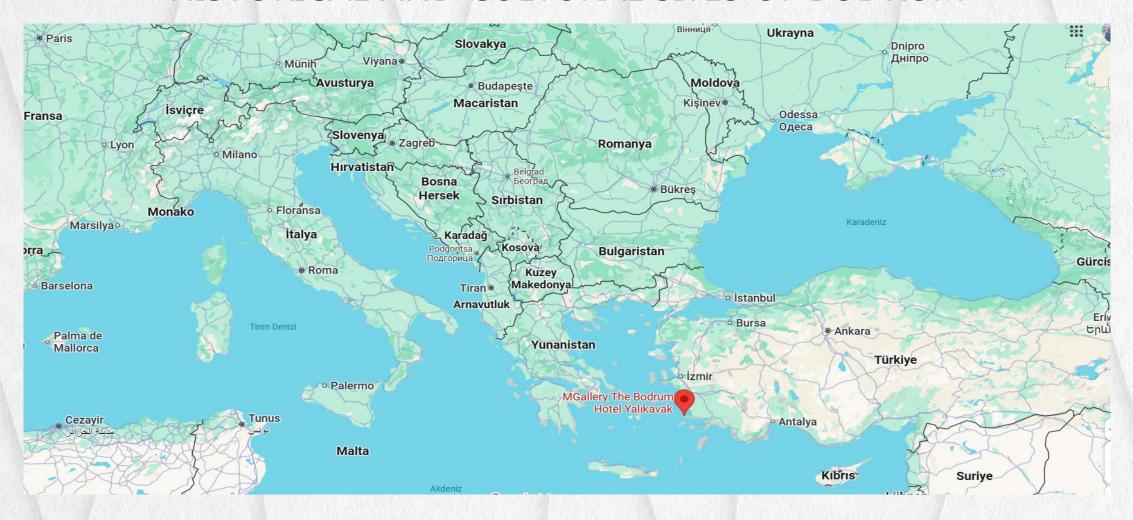

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HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL SITES OF BODRUM





Bodrum is located in the southwest of Turkey, very close to several Greek islands such as Kos and Kalimnos. These islands are even closer to Bodrum than to other Turkish cities; for example, Kos and Kalimnos are only 20 minutes away by the daily high-speed ferry service.





Bodrum was known as Halicarnassus in ancient Caria and was home to the Mausoleum of Mausolus, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

Bodrum, a region that has been continuously inhabited by humans for thousands of years, has a deep history and is important for historians due to its central or nearby location to many major civilizations and events.

The first settlement in Bodrum was established on the small rocky islet where St. Peter's Castle stands today. The castle was built over the ruins of an older structure constructed by the Dorians around 1100 BCE.

Halicarnassus, known as a city from the 7th century BCE onwards, was one of the six members of the Hexapolis Dorian Confederation, alongside cities such as Knidos, Kos, and Rhodes. Herodotus, known as the "Father of History," was born in Halicarnassus in the 5th century BCE.



Bodrum is famous for its historical and natural beauties. It welcomes visitors with important landmarks such as Bodrum Castle, the Windmills, Bodrum Amphitheater, the Mausoleum of King Mausolus, Pedasa, Myndos Gate, Stratonikeia, and the Ottoman Shipyard and Tower. Additionally, the Bodrum Underwater Archaeology Museum is an important destination that sheds light on the region's history.

Bodrum's charm is not limited to its historical and natural attractions. It also stands out with its entertainment options, luxury restaurants, nightclubs, shopping centers, and modern marinas. Especially, Yalıkavak Marina stands out as the center of modern and luxurious living.

BODRUM CASTLE

Built in 1402 by the Knights of St. John as **St. Peter's Castle**, the castle has also been used as an **Underwater Archaeology Museum** since 1960.

It is **20 km away from the hotel**.

BODRUM UNDERWATER ARCHAEOLOGY MUSEUM

Due to its rich underwater collection dating from the 14th century BC to the 16th century AD, the museum was renamed **Bodrum Underwater Archaeology Museum** in 1981. It is the **only underwater archaeology museum in Turkey** and one of the most important in the world. The Bodrum Underwater Museum received the **European Museum Special Commendation Award** in 1995. It is **20 km away from the hotel**.



MAUSOLEUM AT HALICARNASSUS

Built in 350 BC for Mausolus, the ruler of Caria, it is a grand tomb. Its marble structure was so magnificent and its decorative statues so striking that it became one of the **Seven Wonders of the Ancient World**. The term "mausoleum" has since been used to refer to any monumental tomb.It is 15 km away from the hotel.





BODRUM ANCIENT THEATRE

It is the **only structure from classical-era Bodrum** that has survived to the present day. Located on the southern slopes of Göktepe Hill in the center of Bodrum, this theatre is one of the **oldest in Anatolia**. It was restored in the 1960s by a group of Turks, and its **most recent restoration** was carried out in cooperation with Bodrum Municipality, Ericsson, and Turkcell. Today, it **hosts many festivals in Bodrum**.It is **20 km away from the hotel**.





MYNDOS GATE

Built by King Mausolus, **Myndos Gate** is located between Bodrum city center and Gümbet. It is one of the most **important historical landmarks in Bodrum**. It is also known as the **gate that Alexander the Great could not pass**. It is **18 km away from the hotel**.

BARDAKÇI WINDMILLS

The windmills in Bodrum are considered a **symbol of the district**. The first windmills in Bodrum were built in the **1850s on the windy hills**. They are **15 km away from the hotel**.





POINTS TO CONSIDER WHEN VISITING MUSEUMS, HISTORICAL SITES, AND RELIGIOUS OR CULTURAL PLACES

Museums are important places that house objects and stories related to culture, art, nature, science, and technology. The real objects exhibited in museums make learning more engaging and exciting, enabling a more effective educational experience. One of the most important roles of museums is to educate and inform people.

Rules to Follow in Museums:

- ❖ Follow staff instructions: Always obey the directions of museum personnel and adhere to the visitor rules displayed inside the museum.
- **Entrance requirements:** Present your **ID or museum card** if required and ensure you have a valid ticket for entry.
- ❖ Maintain silence: Speaking loudly or making noise inside the museum is prohibited.
- * Respect the exhibits: Do not touch the displayed items or their pedestals, do not write on them, and avoid causing any damage. (This rule also applies to open-air museums and archaeological sites.)
- **Photography rules:** Follow the instructions regarding photography as indicated by the museum.

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Additional Guidelines for Visiting Museums and Religious Sites

- ❖ Photography: Follow the museum's instructions regarding photography, such as whether flash is allowed or not.
- ❖ Listening and Asking Questions: Pay close attention to explanations and ask your guide or, if available, museum educators about anything you are curious about. Thank the staff who provide information.
- ❖ No Food or Drink: Do not bring food or beverages into the museum or site.
- * Keep the Area Clean: Do not litter.
- **Stay with Your Group:** On guided tours, do not leave the group. If you get separated, ask staff for assistance at the information desk.
- Considerate Behavior: Avoid actions that may disturb other visitors.

Guidelines for Religious Tourism (Visiting Mosques, Churches, Synagogues, etc.):

- Follow the religious and cultural rules of the place with respect and tolerance.
- Pay attention to instructions from entry staff.
- Wear appropriate clothing if required.
- ❖ Do not disturb worshippers; remain quiet and respectful.
- Do not bring food or drinks and avoid littering.
- These rules help ensure a safe, respectful, and enjoyable visit for everyone.



RULES TO FOLLOW WHEN ENTERING NATURAL AREAS

- ❖ Follow Staff Instructions: Carefully adhere to all information and warnings provided by staff when entering natural areas. This is important for your safety and for the protection of wildlife.
- ❖ Fire Safety: Do not light fires in wooded or grassy areas. Fires are only allowed in designated camping or picnic areas, and must be controlled and safe.
- ***** Waste Management:

Dispose of all trash in bins.

Do not leave glass, plastic, metal, or cigarette butts in nature.

Use recycling facilities and separate waste when possible.

- ❖ Avoid Restricted Areas: Strictly obey signs such as "Do Not Enter" or "Swimming Prohibited" to protect both your safety and sensitive ecosystems.
- **❖ Protect Plants and Animals:**

Do not harm the habitats of plants and animals.

Avoid picking wild plants or feeding/disturbing animals.

❖ Protect Natural Resources:

Do not pollute water sources, lakes, or streams.

Avoid actions that cause soil erosion or damage the environment.
